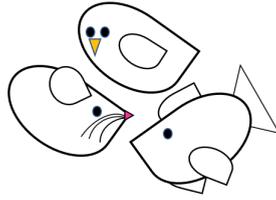

**WARNING** from John at Animal Concern: A phisher is targeting animal welfare groups with the fraudulent scam email reprinted below.

If you receive this or a similar email in the UK please forward it to: [report@phishing.gov.uk](mailto:report@phishing.gov.uk).  
In other countries forward it to your equivalent police agency.

The authorities cannot catch all the scammers but it is important they know the scale of the problem.

Animal welfare agencies in countries where English is not their first language may be at particular risk from this scam.

Sadly the despicable people behind this scam are not unique as there have been many attempts to criminally defraud people using the plight of unfortunate animals as a front. Be cautious and always treat emails either offering you large amounts of money or asking you for even small amounts of money as suspicious. If someone you are not sure of asks you for a donation ask them for their last audited accounts and details of what their CEO and other staff are paid. Check them out against charity or tax records in the country they are based or operating in.

If someone offers you a large donation in an email, such as the one below, **don't even respond**.

Please take care not to waste money that could be put to good use.
